Like an MRI of the eye, but taking only seconds to perform, the **iWellnessExam**[™] provides high definition cross sections of your retina and optic nerve which can reveal signs of disease in exquisite detail that are invisible to traditional examination methods. **Optomap**[®] ultra-wide retinal imaging captures wide-field digital images of the back of your eye. Typical examination techniques allow only narrow fields of view, but the **Optomap**[®] image provides more than 80% of the retina in a single view.

Together, these unique technologies can help detect potentially vision threatening and systemic diseases in their very early stages. They also provide your doctor with a permanent baseline record of your retinal examination for comparison during future exams.

As part of your pre-examination work-up, our technician will perform these two tests which your doctor will review with you during your examination today.
